# Career Guidance and Placement Cell

Every student has a dream to achieve huge success in life. While education is the first step towards realising this dream, we at RKT understand that this is not the end. It is crucial to enhance and at times create the requisite Industrial skills among our students so as to make them qualified for the real competitive world. The Career Guidance and Student Placement Cell of our Institute guides students for various fields and also creates job opportunities for them.

The strong base foundation of RKT College, Ulhasnagar has always set an example for other Institutions in the vicinity to aim for more Academic as well as professional development of the students. A College makes a name across demographic locations only when the students make successful advancements in their career graph.

Career Guidance and Placement Cell has been in charge of the same since the day back then.

Allowing physical limitations to step back, round the clock activities by the cell have been in place irrespective of any shortcomings. The following activities were conducted by the Cell during the Academic year 2019–20:

1.19th July 2019:- The prime, luxurious Job profile for any youngster stands out with an MBA degree. So, the new Academic year started with a Seminar on - "MBA as a CAREER" conducted by Mr Niketan Taware and his team. A lot of students benefited from the Seminar.

- 2. CS and IT students are assumed to be the cream of the College. The Orientation of T.Y. B.Sc. CS and IT students were on **26th August 2019** where the students were informed about the training and internship activities conducted by Career Guidance and Placement Cell every year. They were motivated by I/c. Principal Dr. Shanta Janyani and the Convener of the Cell Prof. Neelam Kapoor.
- 3. **28th August 2019:** Entrepreneurship as a Vocational activity has taken leaps and strides. A Seminar on Entrepreneurial Thinking was conducted to promote the 'Self-starting' attitude in students.
- 4. **29th August 2019:** CET (MBA) free coaching for final year students of Arts, Science and Commerce were Inaugurated by Mr Niketan Taware. 34 students registered for the free coaching and the training was conducted for four months (about 50 lectures).
- 5. **31st September 2019:** EWYL program in collaboration with Kotak Unnati (Kotak Education Foundation) a Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiative of Kotak Mahindra Bank was organized for FY and SY students. The Seminar was taken by the team from Kotak Education (under CSR). A total of 34 students were enrolled for the program that started on 1st October 2019. The duration of the program was about 3.5 months which was offered free of cost with a Guaranteed Placement. It included:
  - Training in Hospitality, Customer Relations and Sales.
  - Training in Spoken English, basic IT skills (NIIT certification), Personality development and other Life Skills.
  - Help with Job Placements.

A total of 20 students completed the program successfully.

- 6. **26th November 2019:** Seminar on "CV Writing and How to Face Interview" was organized by Mr. Niketan Taware, Mrs. Laveena Mangtani and Mr. Bharat Khatri for all the T. Y. students.
- 7. The Cell organised and conducted a Three-day Intercollegiate Career Fair on 12th, 13th and 14th December 2019.
- 8. **16th December 2019:** Mock Interviews and Group discussion session was conducted by Mrs. Laveena Mangtani and Mr. Bharat Khatri for all the T. Y. students.
- 9. A Job Fair was organized on **3rd February 2020**. Total Eight companies participated in the Job Fair and 301 Interviews were conducted.
- 10. **4th February 2020:** Visit to the Hinduja Hospital was organized for T. Y. B. Sc. Students. The purpose of this visit was to attend a Seminar on "Allied Health Science Courses".
- 11. **6th March 2020:** Internship Drive for FY, SY & TY BSc CS & IT students was organized for Dezignolics Pvt. Ltd. and Dcodetech IT Training and Certification Institute. A total of 15 students were selected for the Second Round.







#### Day ONE:-






## Nature Club

## **Admission Committee**

The Admission Committee for the Academic year was formed in May 2019 by Incharge Principal Dr. Shanta Janyani.

The admission process for SY BA/ BCOM/ BSC and TY BA/ BCOM/ BSC started in June 2019. The schedule was put up on the Notice board as per Class and Streamwise, which included proper information about the fee structure, details about the website for filling online forms for College as well as University, etc. Incharge Principal Dr. Shanta Janyani called for a meeting with all Admission committee members to brief about the Admission for the Academic year 2019-20. R.K.Talreja College has a smooth process for Admission at all FY/SY/TY BA/BCOM/BSC LEVEL. Room number 104 and 106 were made available for Commerce, Arts and Science students to avoid long queues and unnecessary trouble to students during admission. The Admission Committee, Teaching and Non Teaching staff were always present in the rooms to help and guide students whenever they needed, in addition to their duty of giving admission. SY/TY BSC admissions were given by Science faculty members who were the members of the Admission Committee, while SY/TY BA/BCOM admissions were given by Non-teaching staff of the Admission Committee in our presence.



### **Department of Physics**

The Sciences are always fresh streams for students to get into. The Department of Physics is an excellent group of students and teachers who put in efforts to bring alive the working knowledge of Physics. Both theoretical and practical knowledge is provided to the students.

### Department of Zoology

The Department of Zoology runs courses from undergraduate to postgraduate classes with Oceanography and fishery technology as specialization. The department has four approved full-time faculties. The department actively involves research guidance to the post-graduate students and projects and assignments to undergraduate students. The vast animal life comes alive in the classroom and the students are taken on trips that allow them to observe the animals and how they live. Many useful techniques are used to teach them this interesting subject.

At the beginning of the academic year, the department conducted an Orientation Program for newly admitted students to the degree program to inform them about the scope of the subject. Students were informed and guided regarding the syllabus, examination pattern, rules of ATKT, courses available after the degree program and careers in Zoology.

10 students of MSc Part 1 students were taken to Palasdari and Matheran on 22nd August 2019 and 17th October 2019, respectively. The aim of visits was to make MSc students understand the habitat, elevation and climate-specific adaptations of invertebrates.





A long excursion to Thattekad-Munnar-Chinnar was organized for MSc, TYBSc and SYBSc students between 3rd February, and 8th February 2020 to explore the vertebrate diversity of Southern Western Ghats with special emphasis on endemic animals. Prof. Parimita Sharma and Prof. Kuldeep Mhatre accompanied 28 students for the excursion. Several endemic animals like Ceylon frogmouth, Nilgiri flycatcher, black-and-orange flycatcher, Nilgiri langur, grizzled giant squirrel, etc were observed during the excursion.

An animal house visit was arranged on 11th March 2020 for 10 MSc Part I students to the Institute of Chemical Technology. Students were allowed to interact with the Head of the department, In-charge of the animal house, Veterinary doctor and Research scholars during the visit.


### **Department of Economics**

Sadhubella Girls College, Ulhasnagar to give a guest lecture on "Economic Aspect of Women Empowerment" to our college students. Prof. Sharmila Karve has accepted this invitation and agreed to deliver a guest lecture on the 7th March 2020 as a part of an event which is widely celebrated as INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY. Prof. Dr. M. S. Dole, the HoD, Department of Economics, welcomed Prof. Sharmila Karve, for this occasion, and she delivered her lecture and clarified conceptual understanding of women empowerment in a very lucid way followed by a question-answer session. Prof. Karve also spoke about how to empower women and spread awareness about gender equality and gender sensitization and encouraged students to abolish gender bias in society. Around 50 students from our college and faculty from different departments joined this lecture. Both students and faculty members benefited from this guest lecture.





# 2. Webinar on "Impact of COVID 19 pandemic on the economy of Drama and Film Industry with Special Reference to India" on 7th June 2020.

Due to the outbreak of COVID 19, followed by the subsequent lockdown, under the Disaster Management Act 2005 by the Government of India as well as the Government of Maharashtra(24th March 2020 onwards), the teaching community has faced a lot of problems to continue our teaching and learning process. Within a short span of time, the Department of Economics decided to conduct a webinar on "Impact of COVID 19 pandemic on the economy of Drama and Film industry with special reference to India" as a part of our department activities.

The expected outcomes of this webinar were as follows:

- To understand the extent of losses in the Drama and Film industries caused due to COVID 19 pandemic.
- To create awareness of the effect of COVID 19 Pandemic on income, investment, employment, mental health and creativity of the stakeholders in the Drama and Film industries.

This webinar was held on the "GoToMeeting" video conference app on **7th June 2020** from 4 pm to 5 pm. The Department of Economics invited **Mr. Denzil Smith**, Senior Veteran Actor, of stage and films, in India and Abroad, and renowned film and theatre actor **Mr. Anshuman Jha**, who was rated as one of the top 10 Bollywood Actor of 2010 by rediff.com and was voted as Advertising Face of the year 2011 by CNBC-TV18 Storyboard. Upon accepting our invitation, both the speakers delivered a resourcefully enriched lecture on the topic. They have highlighted several practical, operational problems in the Film industry and how to cope up with these new challenges and its possible way out of the mechanism, followed by a detailed Q & A session. This webinar has definitely helped our students to understand the impact of COVID 19 on the entertainment industry and inspired many students to opt for a career in the television industry. As per student progression and their benefits part is concerned, participation in this webinar has provided exposure and opportunity to students to learn new things. Interaction with experts during the Q & A session inspired students to make better decisions with respect to career and livelihood.

### Department of English

A survey was conducted to help understand where we are and looking forward, what would be the best for everyone as an effective teaching methodology. Following was the outcome of the survey taken from more than 50 teachers across India.

#### **Analysis of results:**

We had a dataset that was collected from teachers all over India. It was categorized based on different factors such as Age, Gender, Location, Designation and the stream that they teach. The teachers who participated in this survey comprised 24 Males and 30 Females in number. We had data from teachers who belong to states such as Maharashtra, Gujarat, Uttar Pradesh, Telangana, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka amongst a few others. We had about 26 teachers from Arts, 18 from Science and 10 from Commerce. Noting some difficulties, about 7 teachers said that they had less number of students attending their lecture due to various issues such as non-availability of computer, lack of network connectivity, odd life cycle, laziness. We found out that 70.4% of them preferred Whatsapp for either calling or sharing material online with the students. An equal amount of people preferred using Zoom which is currently being used by all the schools, colleges, companies for video conferencing, group discussions and for sharing material with each other.

Surprisingly, out of 54 participants, about 21 rated their experience as Excellent and only 1 participant had a very poor experience. This accounts for 38.9% being comfortable with this online teaching. About 14 participants recorded this process fair with some minor difficulties. When asked about the best feature of the E-Education system, about 24 teachers replied saying they found comfort in teaching from home. It was a bit of a surprise that only 1 teacher considered the reduction in finances as an advantageous aspect while working from home. About 36 teachers found recording the video and either sending it to the students or uploading those on web platforms to be reliable and better than virtual writing board.

One of the interesting things to know from teachers was how did they cope up with not knowing much to getting used to it daily. So, we asked whether they took any help from somewhere and if yes, then what it had been. About 30 teachers said that they followed the informative workshops and certain Faculty Development Programs (FDP) conducted for them so that they could get technical knowledge and that was really helpful for them. Only 5 teachers gave credits to their children for teaching them how to use these platforms for online teaching. Some of the answers included self-learning, friends, YouTube, etc.

The Department of Marathi brings students closer to this language which is an old and beautiful proof of our glorious state.


### **Expressions 2019-20**




#### अंतरराष्ट्रीय हिंदी दिवस (2019-20)



The Maharashtra State Board has changed the syllabus of Standard of XI SCIENCE (ARTS and COMMERCE too), so that



students of Maharashtra State Board can compete at par with the students of other boards, as far as competitive examinations like JEE and NEET are concerned. Since the syllabus has changed, the board has decided to change the pattern of the question paper. This change must be brought to the notice of the teachers teaching the respective subject, so that it can be imparted to the students well in time, to prepare them for the examination well in time, with this new pattern.

To execute this, the board has decided to make a team of senior teachers, who will train the teachers teaching PHYSICS in different institutes from Mumbai Region/Thane District. Avinash Rooge was one of the members of this team representing our institute, as a Resource Person, for Mumbai Divisional Board. The Mumbai Divisional Board has divided the entire Mumbai region into 6 (Six) different centres and prepared the timetable accordingly. The teachers were called to attend the said workshop/seminar to the nearest centre depending on which institute they teach. Every centre has around 100 to 150 such trainees.

The training was conducted from 24th to 27th September 2019, in two sessions, 10.00 AM to 1.00 PM and 2.00 PM to 5.00 PM., every day. The first session started with an introduction of speakers and the purpose of conducting the Workshop/Seminar. It was then followed by explaining the reason for changing and framing the new syllabus. Speakers were given their choice of interest to speak on. Avinash chose to speak on the differences between the current paper and evaluation pattern and the new one. The explanation included do's and don'ts while preparing the question paper and selecting the appropriate questions.

The second session was on how to prepare the blueprint for framing the question paper followed by a question and answer session.

### ऑनलाइन शिक्षण - फायदे आणि तोट

संपूर्ण जगात मागील 2020 वर्षांपासून कोरोना महामारी थैमान घातले आहे. कोरोना महामारी पासून वाचण्या पासून जगामध्ये विविध उपाययोजना करण्यात आल्या त्यापैकी एक म्हणजे "लॉकडाऊन" (टाळेबंदी) होय. लॉक डाऊन च्या काळात लोकांना फक्त आवश्यक सेवांसाठी बाहेर पडता येत होते व बहुतांश वेळ घरात घालवावा लागला . लॉक डाऊन केल्यामुळे कोरोना विषाणूंचा प्रसार कमी झाला व त्यातून कोरोना रुग्णांची संख्या कमी कमी होत गेली व त्यापासून वाचण्यासाठी वारंवार हात धुणे, सामाजिक अंतर ठेवणे या गोष्टींचा वारंवार प्रचार व प्रसार करण्यात आला .

लॉकडाउन मुळे अनेक समस्या निर्माण झाल्या. बेरोजगारी शाळा-कॉलेज यातील प्रत्यक्ष शिक्षण देणाया देण्याच्या देण्याचे थांबले व विद्यार्थ्यांना ऑनलाईन शिक्षण घेणे भाग पडले .

ऑनलाईन शिक्षणासाठी मुळे तसे भरपूर फायदे होती आहे जसे की,मुलांना सकाळीच उठून तयार करणे त्यांच्यासाठी टिफिन बनवणे आणि त्यांना शाळेत वेळेवर सोडवणे, ही कामे टाळले असून त्यामुळे पालकांना भरपूर वेळ मिळत आहे. तसेच विद्यार्थ्यांना ऑनलाईन शिक्षणामुळे कम्प्युटर, लॅपटॉप, पॅड, टॅबलेट, स्मार्टफोन इंटरनेट आणि झूम इत्यादी हाताने चे ज्ञान आले असून त्यांचा वापर ते आपल्या वैयक्तिक जीवनात देखील करू लागले

पण ऑनलाइन शिक्षणामुळे जसे फायदे होत आहे तसेच तोटा देखील समोर येत आहे कारण पालक व मुले अगोदर काही तासच सोबत असत पण ऑनलाइन शिक्षणामुळे ते 24 तास सोबत आहे . त्यामुळे काही वेळेस थोडाफार वाद देखील निर्माण होतो आणि मुलांमध्ये देखील आळस निर्माण होत आहे ,त्याची सकाळी उठण्याची सवय बंद होत आहे. तसेच ऑनलाईन शिक्षणामुळे इंटरनेटचा गैरवापर देखील मुले करत आहे. जसे की ,ऑनलाइन गेम खेळणे, ऑनलाईन व्हिडिओ पाहणे इत्यादी .यामुळे त्यांच्या आरोग्यावर देखील दुष्परिणाम पडत आहे. कारण स्क्रीन समोर बसल्यामुळे डोळ्यांवर ताण येतो येतो .तसेच मान देखील ,मान दुखी पाठ दुखी सुद्धा जाणवते त्यामुळे विद्यार्थी संदर्भात या आरोग्य समस्या निर्माण झाल्या आहेत.

काही अपवाद देखील असले कारण काही पालक मुलांसोबत पहाटे उठून प्राणायम करतात .तसेच या डिजिटल शिक्षणामुळे मुले अजून एकलकॲडी होत आहे कारण ती एकटीच घरून शिक्षण घेत आहे .जर हे शिक्षण एका वर्गात असते तर मुलांमध्ये एकोप्याची भावना निर्माण होते एकत्र सणामुळे मिळवून जाण्याची वृत्ती तयार होते. एकत्र शिक्षणामुळे मिळून मिसळून राहण्याची वृत्ती तयार होते. त्यांच्यात मैत्री निर्माण होते . तसेच त्यांना एकमेकांना मदत करण्याची भावना निर्माण होते.

पण ऑनलाइन शिक्षणामुळे या सर्व गोष्टी घडत नाही आणि सर्वात मोठी अडचण म्हणजे इंटरनेटची उपलब्धता. कारण सर्वच भागात इंटरनेट सुविधा उपलब्ध असेल असे देखील नाही आणि सर्वच पालकांकडे स्मार्टफोन ,कम्प्युटर आणि टॅबलेट असेल असे देखील नाही. कारण आपल्या शाळेमध्ये सर्व स्तरातील मुले असतात. मजुरांची देखील मुले असतात. त्यामुळे त्यांना हे ऑनलाइन शिक्षण घेणे शक्य होईल असे नाही ,त्यामुळे शाळेने सर्वांना सोयीचे होईल अशा सुविधा उपलब्ध करून दिल्या आहेत . ज्या भागात कोरणा रुग्णांची संख्या कमी आहे त्या त्या भागात शाळा सुरू करण्यात आल्या ज्या भागात कोरोना संख्या जास्त आहे .त्या भागात शाळा या बंद ठेवण्यात आल्या त्या भागात ऑनलाईन पद्धतीने सुरू ठेवण्यात आल्या . शाळा सुरू झाल्या पण त्या मर्यादित संख्येमध्ये म्हणजेच आज काही वर्ग आज तर काही वर्ग उद्या अशा पद्धतीने सुरू करण्यात आहेत. .ज्या भागात कोणा संख्या जास्त आहे त्या भागात विद्यार्थ्यांना ऑनलाईन शिक्षण घेणे भाग पडले आहे .

शिक्षण हे वाघिणीचे दूध आणि आणि ते प्यायल्यावर माणूस गुरुराया लागतो असे भारतरत्न डॉ. बाबासाहेब आंबेडकरांनी म्हटले आहे या वाक्यात बराच मोठा अर्थ दडलेला आहे आपल्यासारख्या विकसनशील देशात आज ज्या काही रोजगाराच्या संधी आहेत त्यामुळे त्या मागे आपल्या शिक्षण पद्धतीचा मोठा वाटा आहे तसेच माणसाच्या परिवर्तनाचे शेवटचे म्हणजे प्रशिक्षण आणि शिक्षण घेताना आलेले आले नाही तर म्हणजे या यावर मात करण्यासाठी ऑनलाइन शिक्षण पद्धतीचा मोठ्या परमाणावर चांगला वापर होऊ शकतो

ऑनलाइन शिक्षणासाठी नाव नाही नॲदलेले बरेच विद्यार्थी नियमित उपस्थित राहत नाहीत असे ही सर्व दिसून आले याचे कारण उपकरणाची किंवा इंटरनेट अनुपस्थिती टक्के मुले त्यांच्या पालकांची घर घर घरातील कोणाचीतरी मोबाईल वापरतात आहेत अर्थात त्यातील बहुतांश मुले ही उपकरणे हवे तेव्हा हव्या तेवद्या वेळात वापरण्याची मुभा आहे मात्र उपकरण दिवसभर मिळत आहेत असे ते 20 टक्के विद्यार्थ्यांनी सांगितले घरात एखादा मोबाईल असले तर त्यांनी चा वापर पालक अन्य भावंडे अशा सर्वांमध्ये विभागून दिला जातो वर्ग चालू असल्याने बॅटरी चार्ज करण्यासाठी वेळ मिळत नाही असे अनेक ठिकाणी नमूद केलेली इंटरनेटची कनेक्टिविटी नीट नसणे हे आव्हान तर बहुतेकां पुढे आहे.

आता कुठे एक वर्षानंतर सर्व लोकं उघडून सर्व समाजिक पूर्व स्थिती आले होते त्यातच पुन्हा करून रुग्णांची संख्या वाढायला सुरुवात झाली आहे. आता पुन्हा सर्व जनतेला कोरोना रोगा पासून वाचण्यासाठी मास्क लावणे .सामाजिक अंतर व पुन्हा पुन्हा हात धुणे याबाबत सूचना देण्यात येत आहेत.

ज्या ठिकाणी शाळा सुरू झाले होत्या आता पुन्हा त्या शाळा बंद होऊन . ऑनलाईन शिक्षण सुरू झाले आहे.
